2010 Region 17 Spring Meeting Report submitted by Karen Caughell

The 2010 Region 17 Spring meeting was held in Kelowna BC on March 13. It was hosted by the BC Interior Arabian Horse Association. There were 16 delegates that attended as well as several guests. There weren't any real contentious issues this year so the meeting went quite smooth and fast.

Terry reported that AHA will be adding a \$10.00 (optional) fee for the Modern Arabian Horse magazine to any memberships purchased after April 1st. If you want to receive the magazine, you will have to pay the fee. There was some confusion over the Equine Canada amateur cards. If you show in the US, USEF requires Canadian amateurs to have a USEF amateur card. Equine Canada changed the amateur rules (again!) and now amateurs are allowed to make money from teaching lessons to beginners only. This is causing a conflict with Canadian amateurs showing in the US as US amateurs are not allowed to make ANY money from giving lessons or coaching. Equine Canada cards are not always recognized at US shows, so if any Canadian amateurs are going to show in any US shows, they need to apply to USEF for an amateur card. The USEF and EC do have a reciprocal agreement for amateurs and the amateurs will not have to pay for a membership. Equine Canada is going to REQUIRE that anyone living and showing in Canada HAVE an Equine Canada membership card. Several Canadians have joined USEF and not Equine Canada. These people MIGHT be able to get away with their USEF card for 2010, but in 2011 you MUST have an Equine Canada membership card.

AHA has a club information section in their magazine. If you have any club information you want to put in it, contact Marcia Friesen and she will get the information to AHA.

The Show Commission has replaced the trophies for the show. They are going back to the Boma trophies that we had for several years. The Champions will be brown and the Reserves will be white. The Reserves will be smaller than the Champions. The base will be different than what we had in the past. These are very classic trophies and everyone really liked them. They are made in BC and the costs (and shipping, duty and customs) will be less than what we have been paying in the past. There are still several trophies left in the inventory from the past few years. These trophies will be given out at the show in random classes. This was done to be fair so that the first classes of the show don't all get the old trophies and the later classes get the new ones. The 2011 show will be held in Red Deer and the judges have already been selected. The Judges Selection committee received numerous suggestions for judges. They couldn't use some of the names given as the Judges didn't have the required large "R" to judge a Regional show. If you have any suggestions for judges for future shows, contact one of the three members on the committee. (Darlene Brouwer, Marcia Friesen and Nicki Muller)

Gerald McDonald reported on the Canadian Nationals. They have added 6 Select classes (PB and HA WP, HP and CEP all AATR) There will be NO cross entry allowed. For example, you can show in the Select WP AATR class, but you can not show in the WP AAOTR or AATR class. You can show in any other class in any other division, but you can't cross enter in that division if you are in a Select class. The horse can go in another division class with a different rider. For example, the daughter can show the horse in a JOTR or AAOTR class and the mother can ride the same horse in the Select class as long as the horse has all the required qualifications. The Jumper class has been combined to be PB and HA since the two separate might only have one horse per class. They have added the Sport Horse in Hand classes (open only). They are NOT giving out full Top 10s in 2010. A resolution was passed at Convention to award full top 10s starting in 2011. Someone was mistakenly telling people that the Canadian Nationals were awarding full Top 10s this year. The show will be in the new facility. I have been asked by AHA to get sponsorships for the show to help cover some of the costs. A class sponsorship is \$300.00US and includes a business card size ad in the program. They are also selling banners in the arenas at \$300.00 per banner per arena. If you are interested (or know of a person, farm or business) that is interested, please call me.

The Western Canadian Breeders Championships will be held this year in BC by the AAHA of BC. The show is in May. They are looking for sponsorships and they are \$150.00 per class. Contact Nicki Muller or Kimberly Toye if interested. The show will be held in Saskatoon in 2011.

The Team Arabian for the Battle of the Breeds has formed an association to raise fund to compete at Spruce Meadows. This has always been a topic of discussion at every meeting as to what the Region should pay for. It was learned that the Team registration must come from the breed registry, so the CAHR will now pay for the teams entry. They will still need money to cover their expenses as it is very expensive to take a horse to Spruce Meadows for a week. A motion was made to provide the Team with \$2000.00 to help cover the costs. This falls under the Breed promotion category.

Region 17 will be hosting the 2011 AHA Convention in Vancouver. Region 17 will be looking for various sponsorships and donations to help make this convention a great one. They need sponsorships for the coffee breaks, door prizes, gifts for the Directors, and items for the delegates bags (pens, notepads, Chap Stick, hand sanitizer, candy, etc.) Contact Terry Johnson for more information.

The Fall meeting will be held October 2nd, but the location hasn't been determined yet. Parkland has been asked if they would like to hold it as they had asked for the Spring meeting, but the BCIAHA had asked first. The meeting will most likely be in Calgary or Edmonton.
