1. **October minutes** adopted as read by Dana Leadbeater, seconded by Sandy Schroter.
2. **Membership** report given by Jill Bromley. 111-adult 1 yr, 32- adult 3 yr, 1 lifetime, 18 youth.
3. **Treasurer** report given by Kim Kelemen. Canadian Account as of November 8, 2010 \$50,749.57. US account balance November 8, 2010 \$9,461.26. June show report given, profit made of \$10,436.69. Kim shared that she is missing the 2009 show numbers for GST amounts to complete the GST. Discussion occurred about where to find them, contact Dawn to see if it is in storage.
5. **Youth** Report given by Terri Martin. Penny Carnival was a huge success. \$450 profit made. It was nice to see lots of members out with their kids and grandkids. December 3 is the next youth meeting at Terri Martins house. They will be discussing the Fun and Furry show and membership drive.
6. **Club promotion** report given by Lorie Fisher. The youth photo of the month contest is happening now on the web. They are developing rings for the tradeshow and horse masks. The post-card and calendar idea has been launched in the newsletter. Anyone who wanted to advertise should start sending information to Lorie or Gary. Bookmarks are made. 

## **2010 AHA Convention Report**

The 2010 AHA Convention was held in Orlando Florida. The location itself was a good incentive to go to Convention. Out of 498 eligible delegates, 325 attended. Many went early to go to Disneyworld and Universal Studios. After playing at the tourist attractions, business began on the Wednesday afternoon with the plenary session. This was where the proponents of the resolutions have two minutes to talk about their resolution. It gives the delegates a chance to ask the proponent about the resolution.

AHA currently has 30,000 members. That is down from 2009 when we had 32,000 members. The registrations are also down. In 2010 there were 4065 purebred Arabians registered and in 2009 there were 4395. For the half Arabians there were 1403 in 2010 and 1593 in 2009. AHA had a profit of \$155,000 in 2010. The income comes from the memberships, registrations, shows and the magazine. AHA only owes money to itself (payback to the Sweepstakes program). Regular payments are being made to get that paid back.

### **Amateur Committee**

The committee reviewed several of the resolutions. They also discussed the AOTS rules. Apparently there have been problems that trainers have been riding or warming up the horses at the shows and that isn't allowed in the rules. There was discussion about how to enforce it. The topic came up again of amateurs who are not related to co-own a horse together and both be able to show in the amateur owner classes. The general consensus was that there are AATR classes so they can show in those instead of having to own the horse together.

### **Awards Committee**

The Awards Committee is still looking at another award to go after the Legion of Excellence. That would be for horses that don't have halter points as well as performance points. The Ambassador Award was given to Khist Bythe Wind. The Ambassador Award is given to an Arabian or part Arabian for outstanding achievement in representing the Arabian horse to the general public. Ex: parades, demos, horse show-cases, etc)

The Open Competition Award was given to Made In The Shade+/, MSU Magic J+// and Sau Paulo+/. This award is given to Arabians and part Arabians that have outstanding achievement in Open Competition (all breeds events). This would include open dressage shows, eventing, jumping, reining, carriage driving, working western, competitive trail and endurance.

### **Convention Planning**

The 2011 AHA Convention will be held in Vancouver BC in Region 17. The dates will be November 16-20. Region 17 will be looking for sponsors for the coffee breaks, wine for the tables, and promotional material for the delegate bags. Region 17 will be printing 400 extra Directories to have one put in each delegate bag. Region 17 (with the help of the Region 18 delegates) put on a skit with a power point presentation to invite the delegates to come to Vancouver in 2011. It was an absolute HIT! The delegates were talking about how good it was and they are planning on coming to Vancouver. Some of the skit photos can be seen on the AHA web site under Convention, Daily updates and Nov. 20.

### **Points Committee**

There were no changes made to the current points qualifications. There was some discussion about having no points qualifications and instead go to a shows qualification. For example if you want to go to regionals, you must attend two class A shows in that region to be qualified. If you wanted to go to Nationals, you must attend four class A shows or have a regional win to qualify you. This could make it difficult if you wanted to show in a different region. Some regional Directors won't approve a qualifying show to be held in a different region so if you wanted to show in say Region 4, you would have to haul to Region 4 and

show in two class A shows there in order to show at their regional show. The committee is looking for feedback regarding the points and qualifications. If you have any comments, please contact me.

### **National & Regional Classes Committee**

There are two lists that are governed by this committee. One is the Standard class list that class A shows can offer classes from. The other is the National class list that the National shows can offer classes from. There were several classes added to the Standard list. The majority of these are in the Sport Horse division. A few classes were added to the National list. These are PB and HA Sport Horse under Saddle JTR and AATR. They also added PB and HA Trial Jr. Horse. There was a request from the "halter boys" that there be a Supreme Champion and Reserve Champion halter horse at the US Nationals. The US show commission will decide if they will offer this.

### **Sweepstakes Committee**

I wasn't able to get to this meeting. I did hear that the points payout amount for 2010 will be \$10.00 per point. The Sweepstakes program is stable. They are still working on the Premier Breeders Sweepstakes program. Gary Millar is on this committee, so if you have any questions, you can contact him.

### **Working Western Committee**

This committee reviewed the resolutions. They broke into groups and discussed the items that concerned them. The Reiners would like to have two separate classes at the US Nationals for the futurity horses. One class for four year olds and one for five year olds. They said that the four year olds have a tough time competing with the five year olds. If the classes were separated by age, they would see more entries. There were 16 entered in the PB class in 2010. They didn't have the breakdown of how many per age. The Trail people suggested that since there will be a full Top 10 in 2011, that at the Canadian Nationals, that all horses ride twice and they have an accumulative score. So if there were 5 entered, they ride once, then all five ride again and both scores are added together to determine your champion and reserve and the ranking of the Top 10. They also would like to see a Trail JTR class added to the Canadian Nationals.

In the Youth Division, congratulations to Isabelle Ehret who placed 5<sup>th</sup> with 289 points.

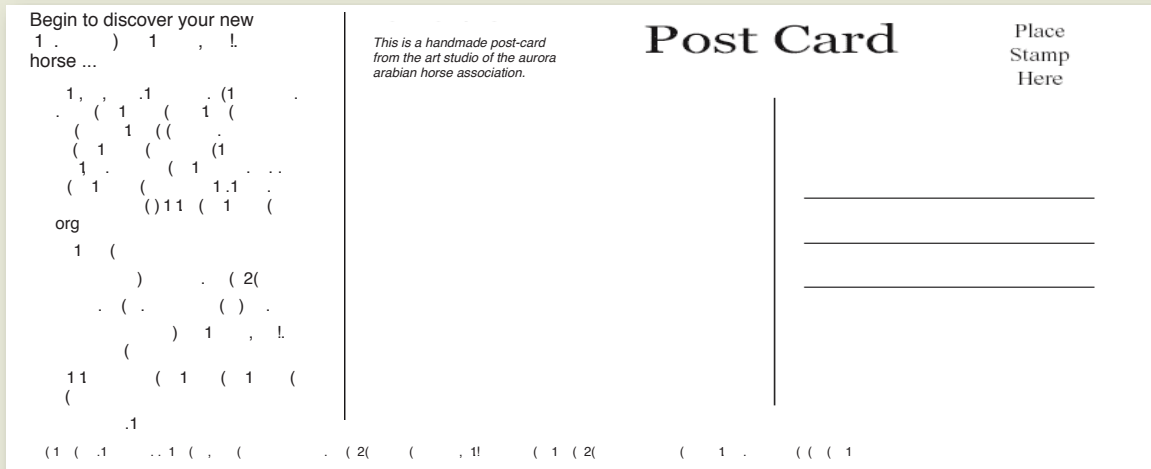
In the Horse awards category, there were five horses in the Top 10 from Region 17.
